DESCRIPTION

Sikamix MA 103 is a powdered admixture used in the production of dry pack mortars. **Sikamix MA 103** plasticises and air entrains the formulation to produce a controlled reliable mortar.

USES

Sikamix MA 103 has been especially formulated for use in pre bagged and bulk silo mix mortars.

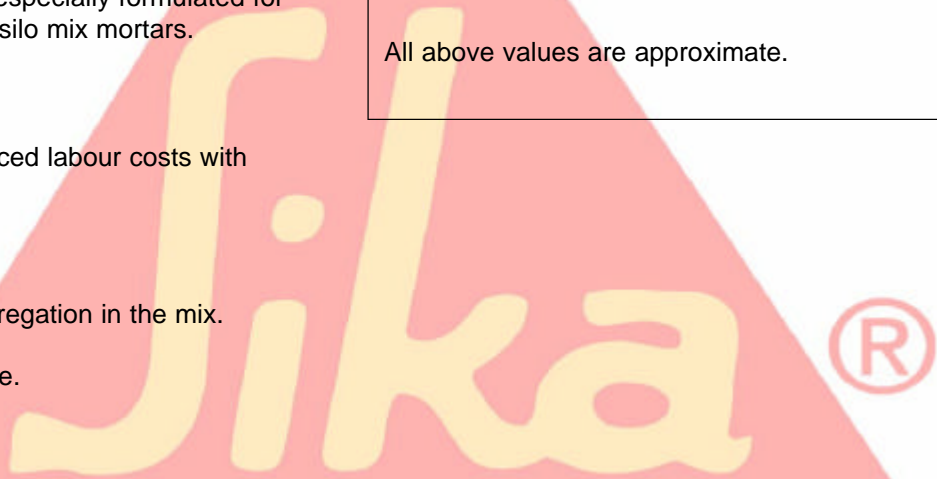

METHOD OF USE

Sikamix MA 103 should be added during the production process and the optimum dose obtained from laboratory trials.

PACKAGING

Sikamix MA 103 is supplied in 25kg packs. Bulk deliveries can be arranged.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Sikamix MA 103 should be stored in sealed containers between 5°C and 25°C and protected from frost. Under these conditions the shelf life is 1 year minimum.



Handling Precautions

Sika products are generally harmless provided that certain precautions normally taken when handling chemicals are observed. The materials must not, for instance, be allowed to come in contact with foodstuffs or food utensils and measures should also be taken to prevent the uncured materials from coming in contact with the skin, since people with particularly sensitive skin may be affected.
